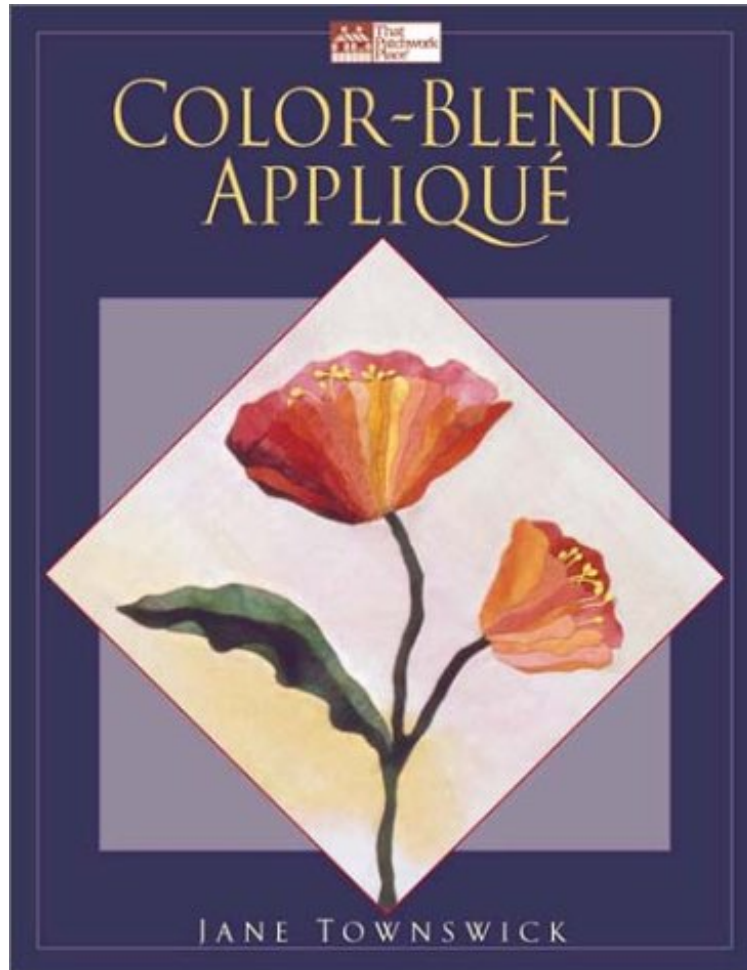

Jane gives her appliqu instructions for 12 flower blocks, in this book. (This doesnt mean you are limited to creating just the 12 blocks.)As with 90% of any crafting/sewing/quilting book, the first few pages are always the authors ideas on the how to do instructions, then comes: either patterns or pictures of the projects.As with this book, it follows the same stereo typical concept of the how to do. But then she puts in a gallery of photos. OMG! They are just breath taking. And to learn that average quilters are the ones that made the blocks, just adds that much more beauty to it all. It gives the reader that knowledge/sense of pride that they too can recreate one of these beautiful flowers.FYI. Make sure you read her books in release/publishing order. Otherwise it gets a little confusing. I think she started her appliqu series off with
