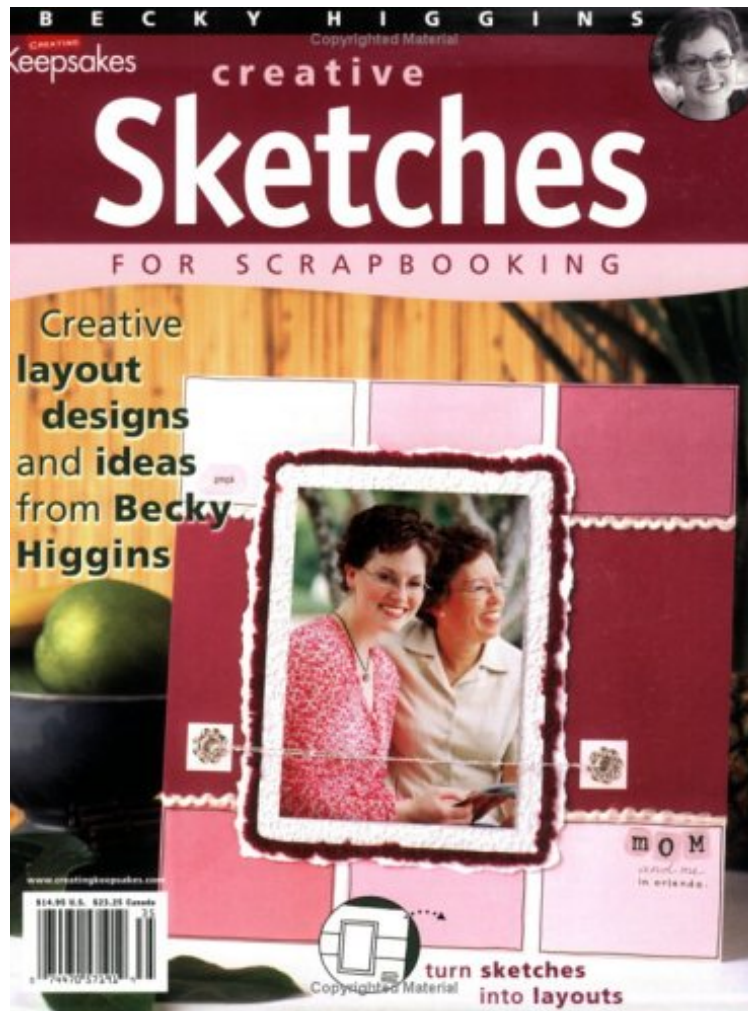

You might find an idea or two that suits you and you tear out those pages and throw the rest of the book or magazine away. This book is completely different - you will want to keep the whole thing and refer to it again and again. First, it starts with a sketch - where to place your pictures, embellishments etc. Then it shows pictures of how that sketch was used on actual scrapbook pages - some are literal translations of the sketch and some offer variations on the theme. The sketches are intended for a 2 page layout using a scrapbook 8 1/2" x 11" or larger. Best of all, there are chapters for sketches using 4-5 photos, 6 photos, 7, 8, 9 and 10+ photos. So once you have an idea of the number of photos you

want to use, then you refer to that specific chapter for ideas. Then, at the very end of the book, the entire collection of sketches is reprinted so you can take them all in at a glance. I was disappointed that the book was actually a flimsy magazine and for the price I would have passed. Many of the pages are filled with advertisements. The layouts were uncreative and nothing exciting. The recipes were also not as descriptive and complete as others that I've seen. I also found that if you do not have children many of the ideas were not useful. I would not recommend this magazine. There are plenty of other choices that are better for the money. This magazine is not robust to sustain any tough handling. As someone who rarely scraps more than two photos to a page, and most likely one, I was very disappointed. I'm returning it immediately.
