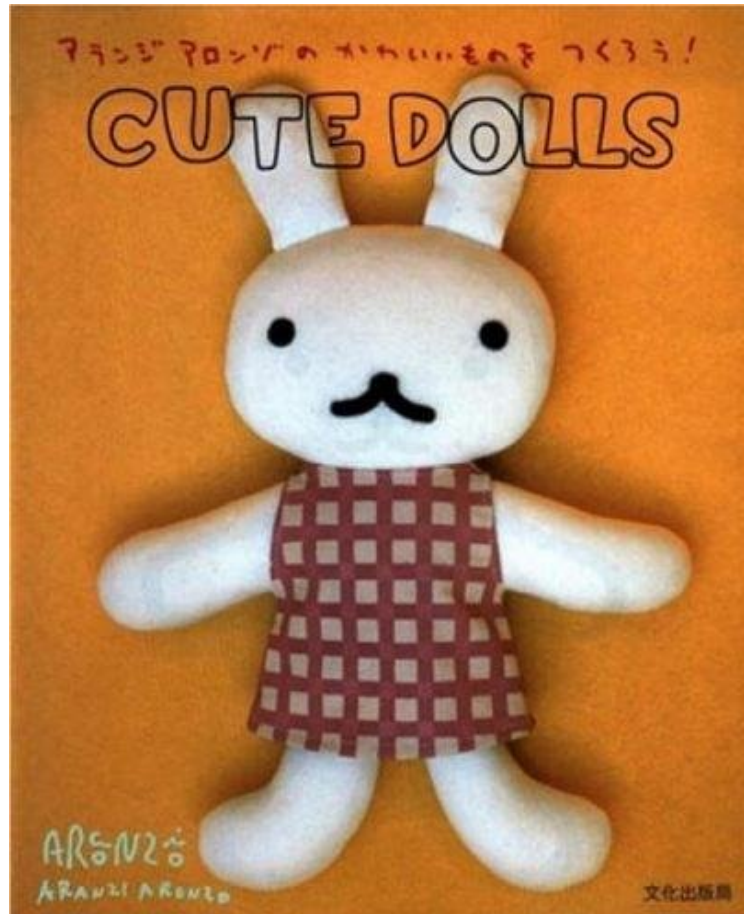

Cut two of that shape out of fabric, sew the edges together, turn inside out, and stuff. That's basically this entire book. Don't waste your money unless you are the type of person who likes to copy project patterns exactly. This book IS good for that. But for people who like to learn from a pattern and then use it to create their own projects, give this one a miss. It does have a little stitch guide and some information about how to turn fabric and stuff that's probably useful for totally new sewers, but it's nothing you can't get off the internet.
