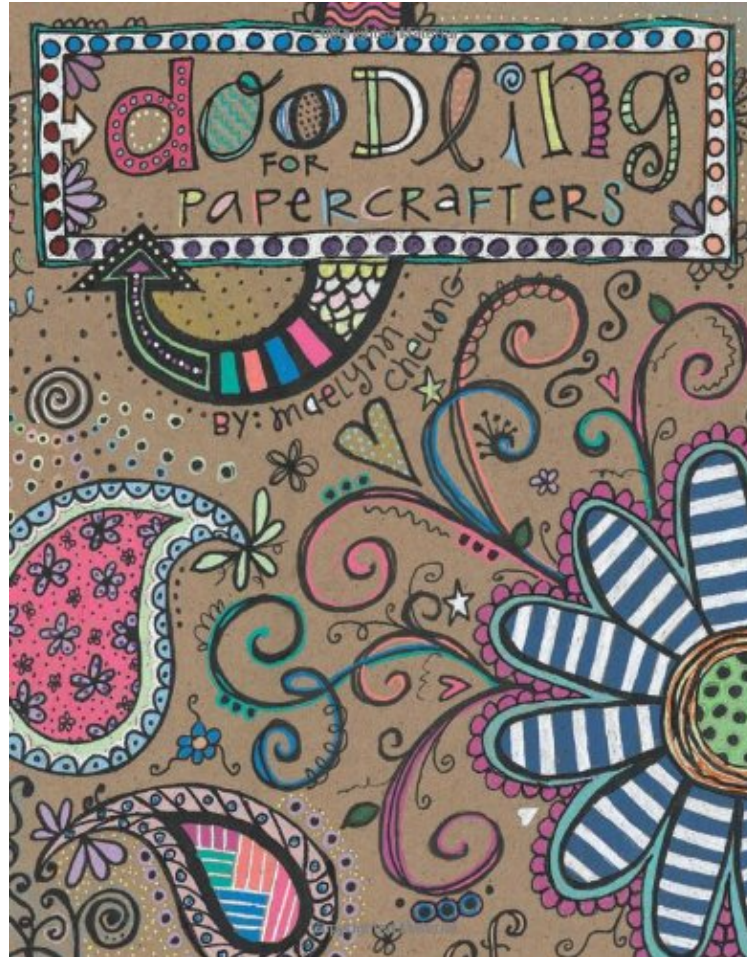

Unlike "Doodle Formula" (an absolute disappointment) this book actually manages to both inspire and teach. She breaks the 'doodling' into categories--flowers, paisleys, borders, etc--and gives a few options for making them look different. These options are just enough to, in and of themselves, give a beginning scrapbooker or doodler a good toolbox, but also leaves enough undone that you feel like, hey, I can come up with my own variation on this! The pictures of other scrapbook pages (because, despite the title, it IS targeted mainly to scrappers) show that even these seemingly simple techniques can and do work wonders at unifying a page in both color and shape. I would have wished a bit more commentary, but just looking at the pictures builds my confidence--I can do *that*, and *that* looks pretty good! And, to be honest, the 'flower' chapter was a bit weak. It wasn't about flowers as much as tracing around

chipboard. Which is a neat technique, don't get me wrong, but a bit different than doodling flowers. It's a cute and inspiring book that tries to do the impossible--teach you how to be spontaneous and creative.
