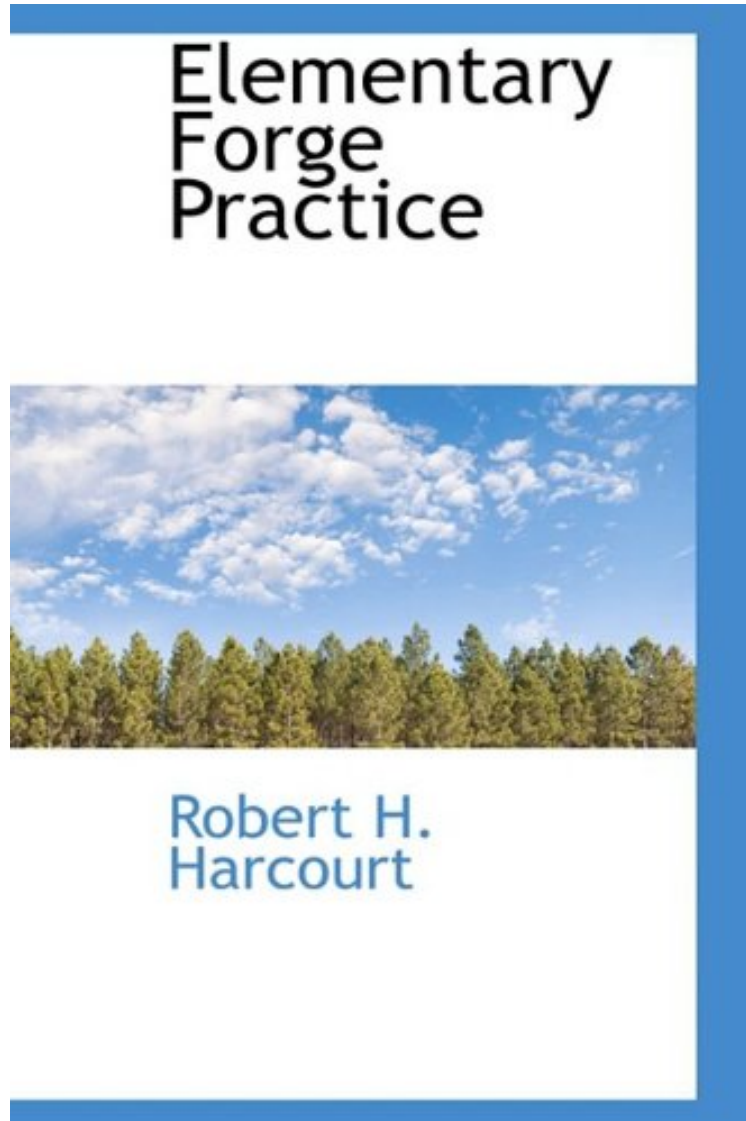

It was recommended to me by Frank Turley and I second his recommendation. This is a good addition to any blacksmith's or aspiring blacksmith's library.That said, avoid the BiblioBazaar reprint edition. The reproduction notes states "While we have attempted to accurately maintain the integrity of the original work(s), from time to time there are problems with the original book scan that may result

in minor errors in reproduction include imperfections such as missing or blurred pages [...]"Translation: "We found an old copy of the book and ran it through a scanner without bothering to try to fix any of the problems."Well, folks, this edition contains a \_lot\_ of missing pages. Many of the missing pages are illustration plates what would be useful to have included in the book. In a work of this nature, this can hardly be called a "minor" problem. It is a major problem that badly affects the usefulness of the book.Summing up: Buy the book, but don't buy the BiblioBazaar edition.

This is a pre-1923 historical reproduction that was curated for quality. Quality assurance was conducted on each of these books in an attempt to remove books with imperfections introduced by the digitization process. Though we have made best efforts - the books may have occasional errors that do not impede the reading experience. We believe this work is culturally important and have elected to bring the book back into print as part of our continuing commitment to the preservation of printed works worldwide.
