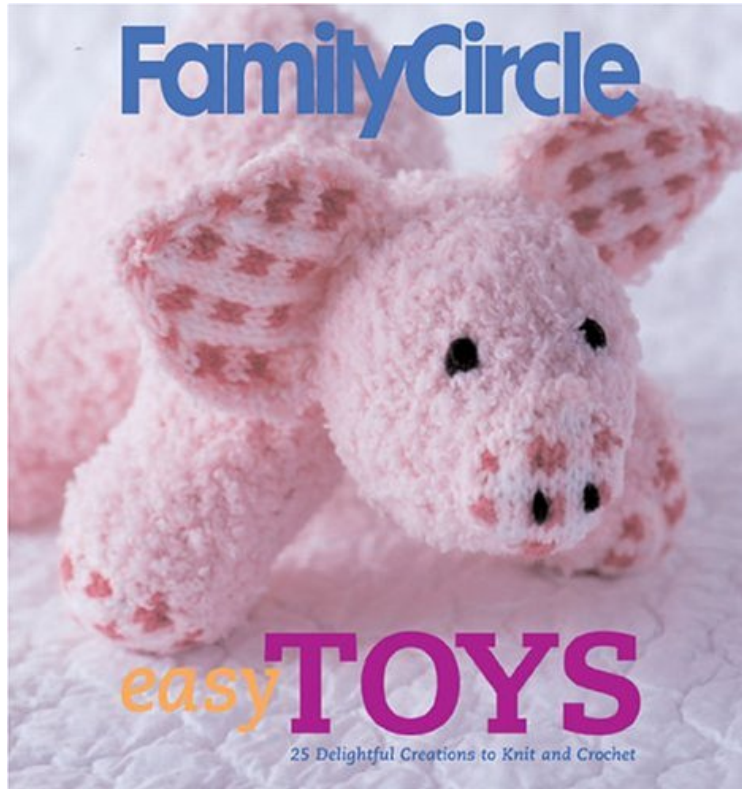

Annoni I am an experienced knitter, and am not pleased with the book. There are two items I was interested in making, the pig and the large teddy bear. The yarn requirement for the pig was off -- it called for one skein of the main color, but really needed 1 skein plus a couple yards. The yarn recommended for the large bear is a discontinued color. While it is possible to use a different yarn with the same gauge, it will not be the bear in the photo. I am very hesitant to try any other patterns in the book.

With some knitting needles, yarn, and these 25 patterns for colorful toys from the experts at Family Circle, it's possible to create an entire playroom's worth of fun for children. Watch a kid's eyes grow wide at the sight of such items as a

friendly stuffed monkey and stackable alphabet blocks. A spirited puppy has a velvet button nose and his own special sweater to wear.
