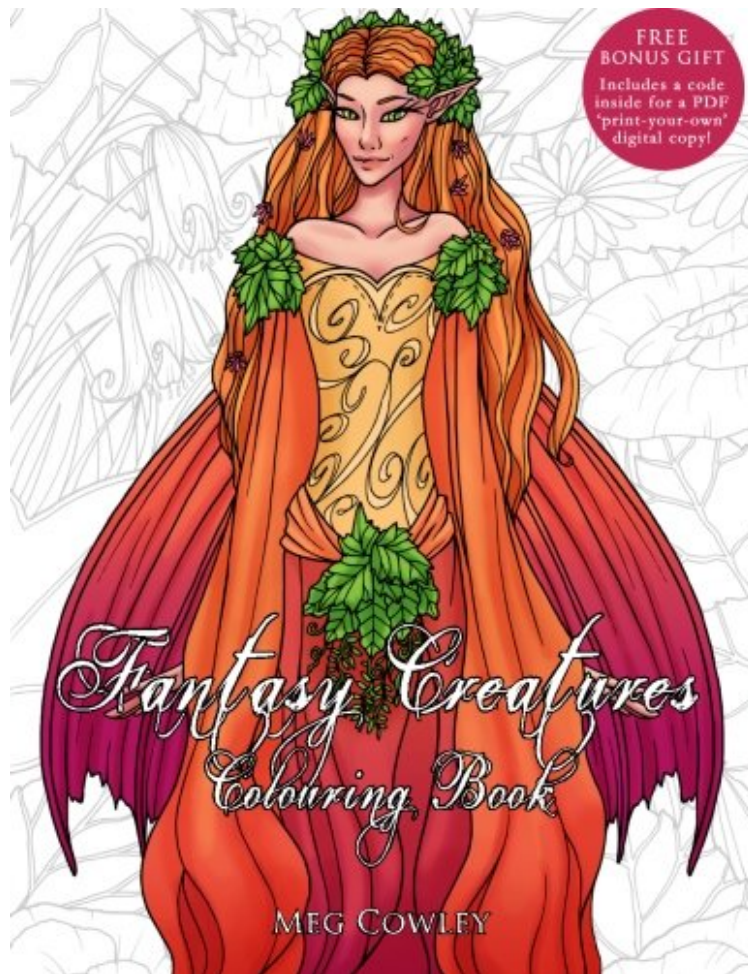

images, 6 pages of introductory material, a colorable title page, and 2 biographical pages at the end. It measures 8.5 x 11 inches and is glue bound into a laminated cover. Featuring black and white line drawings, this book is appropriate for adult colorists on all skill levels. Paper: The paper in this book is bright white and about the same thickness as standard copy weight. There is one image per page with the title printed on the reverse. All pages are non-perforated. Most mediums will be okay to use, but markers may cause some pulling and have heavy bleedthrough. As always, be sure to place several sheets of blotter paper under your current picture to prevent color transfer. Artwork: As the title suggests, "Fantasy Creatures" focuses on mythological people and animals. Inside you'll see fairies, dragons, mermaids, fauns, dryads, krakens, and more. They range in difficulty from simple headshots to full body images with background elements. All of the pictures are surrounded by a thin black border and do not end before entering the binding, so pages can be removed without losing anything. Detail level ranges from quite simple to fairly complex and picture completion time should range from 1 to 5 hours (may be slightly different for each individual). Overall, this is a nicely compiled book with unique artwork. It would be best suited for pencil/chalk colorists who enjoy fantasy imagery.
