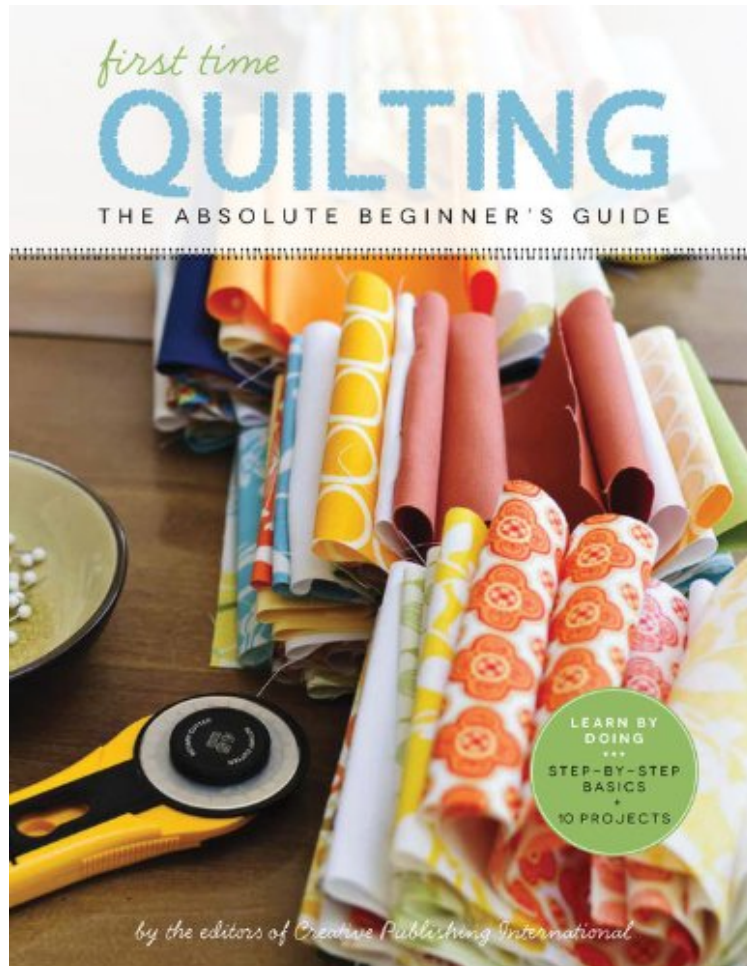

It's more of a beginner sewer's book, starts out by showing you how to thread a sewing machine--not necessary because an owner's manual will tell you that. It doesn't really lead you from step one to finish in a consistent, logical step. At one point, they show you quilting the top but don't explain how you come to choose a design or anything else about the actual quilting other than trace a template design and sew. (pg. 79 )The binding is shown as one type and doesn't even mention the mitered corner type. Should have been some illustration on the grains

of the fabric, instead of the sewing machine stuff. Then it tells you "stitch in the ditch". Ok, I happen to know what that means but if you don't, forget it, it doesn't explain it. I am new to quilting, but not sewing and I found this book to be pretty useless. Very disappointed. I learn more on YouTube videos.
