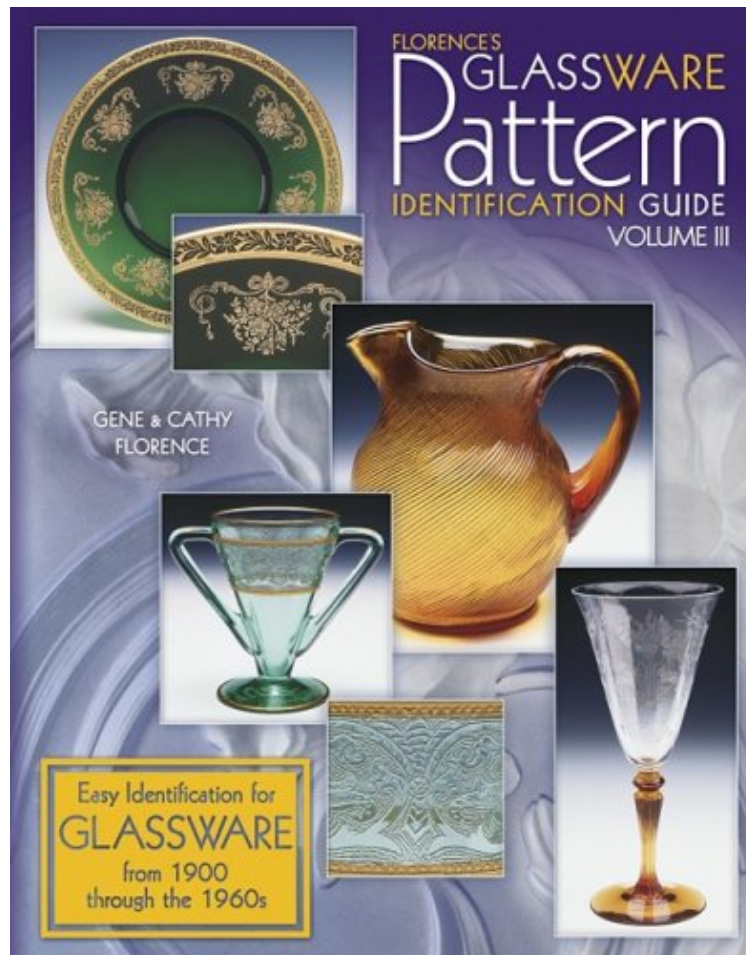

With every photo, pattern names, the company which made the glass, dates of production, all of the colors, and quantity of pieces

available, are provided.
